Since COVID-19 impacted our Ys and our state in March 2020, our nonprofit YMCAs have continually served to strengthen communities. We shifted facilities and operations to best support and care for children, seniors and neighbors in need during the pandemic.

18,250 wellness calls to seniors and others at risk to lend help and reduce loneliness



Provided remote learning support to **528** children at **24** sites to keep students learning (Aug-Dec)



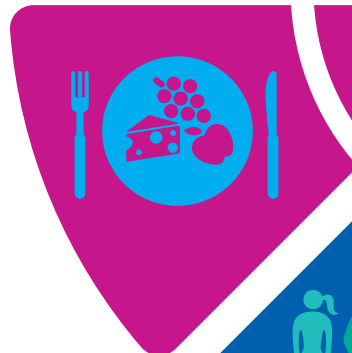
Nurtured **120,595** children at **30** emergency child care sites or summer day camps (March-Aug)



Provided **120,000** children with a safe, supportive and enriching afterschool environment



Collaboratively distributed nearly **1.5 million** meals and served over **511,000** individuals from March - December 2020



32 distinct public health partnerships aimed at mitigating COVID-19



Kept Y members and program visitors safe with over **1.3 million** visits and **.006%** reportable COVID-19 cases with no reported spread



Maintained full and part-time employment for **3,635** employees in 2020
